

Second Sunday of Easter: "The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common. With great power the apostles bore witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great favor was accorded them all. There was no needy person among them, for those who owned property or houses would sell them, bring the proceeds of the sale, and put them at the feet of the apostles, and they were distributed to each according to need."

In the days following the death of Jesus, there was great confusion. In the days following the resurrection of Jesus, the confusion increased. There were some who accepted, some who questioned, some who were uncertain and some who denied. Thomas was one who was uncertain, questioned, denied, and accepted all at the same time.

Ultimately, there would be some resolution to the uncertainty as the early believers would live as community in the Risen Christ. The purpose of community was to bear witness to Jesus Christ. Religious and Lay communities even today exist for this purpose. Living one's life as a Christian, whether in community or not, is a lifelong investment with many "ups and downs".

Secular culture sees the world with an "I did it my way" attitude. The Christian, who lives a life of faith, knows it is never about 'me' it is about God. The Christian approaches death with the assurance of eternal life because of Jesus. The secular culture approaches death as unfair. The Christian culture approaches death as arrival home with God.

"This joy in God, this freedom which raised us in faith and in hope above the bitter struggle that is the lot of man caught between the flesh and the Law, this is the new canticle in which we join with the blessed angels and the saints in praising God.

Let us not then darken the joy of Christ's victory by remaining in captivity and in darkness, but let us declare His power, by living as free people who have been called by Him out of darkness into his admirable light." Thomas Merton

**THIS** weekend is the monthly nonperishable food collection for our food pantry. Please bring your donations for the collection weekend of April 6/7. Thank you!





### St. Vincent de Paul Conference


