From Fr. Mark's Desk:

Easter Sunday: "Then Simon Peter came, following the other disciple, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen wrappings lying there, and the cloth that had been on Jesus' head, not lying with the linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who reached the tomb first, also went in and he saw and believed."

In the physical presence of another our reality can seem obvious. In the spiritual presence of another our reality can seem uncertain. Yet, we know we can love or care for another, whether in their physical presence or not. With the disciples, the physical absence of Jesus is understood as the beginning of a spiritual existence with Jesus that will carry them going forward. They will share that spiritual reality with others, and ultimately, faith will lead to a perpetual understanding of God with us. The resurrection of Jesus is the defining moment of God's covenant with us. Jesus has saved and redeemed. Peter and John understand this, and so now, do we. The Son who died now lives forever, a spiritual certainty.
