

## From Fr. Mark's Desk:

Third Sunday of Easter: "The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of the bread."

The recognition of the risen Jesus continues in His appearance to the two disciples. They had been on a journey away from the place where Jesus died. Jesus would appear to lead them back. The recognition occurs in the breaking of the bread, the Eucharist. As post resurrection people ourselves, the Eucharist is our source and summit in knowing the Lord.

Pope Benedict XVI refers to the Eucharist as the 'Food of Truth' and 'Strength for the weary'. As food, the Eucharist is our spiritual nourishment, the grace of God within us. As truth, it reveals God dwelling among His people. *"I Am the Bread of Life, all who eat this bread, will live forever."* As strength, the Eucharist, our daily bread, gives us the ability to face each day with divine purpose. As for the weary, the Eucharist renews our spirit, worn out by life.

The recognition of Jesus in the Eucharist opens our eyes to all the ways God has revealed Himself throughout time, especially the law of Moses, the prophets and the psalms. In the Eucharist we are made aware of our destiny with God, started long ago and leading into the eternal future.

In the Holy Mass, heaven and earth come together in a single moment. "Heaven and earth are full of your glory, Hosanna in the highest." There is no better place to recognize the risen Jesus than in the Mass.

The Gospel today concludes with the reminder from Jesus that we are witnesses of all that God has revealed. The challenge is a willingness to share that Easter joy with all people, like the early Christian community.

~ As you are aware, it is likely that I will be the only priest serving Our Lady of the Ridge/St. Linus beginning early June. If that changes, I will obviously let you know. With that impending reality, I will have to alter the current Mass schedule. I realize many will understand and some will find it unacceptable. I choose to look at the situation through the lens of what we have rather than what seems a loss.


