

From Fr. Mark's Desk:

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time: "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men."

I have never been patient enough to enjoy fishing. I understand why many like it and appreciate fishing's importance. Yet, the idea of finding where the fish are located and then having to lure them and wait for them seems tedious. But the analogy to humanity makes sense in relationship to God. Often, it is God who seeks where we are, attempts to lure us, and then waits for us to respond. We are tempted by the idea that our 'yes' to God is God's first attempt to save us. The truth, though, is that God has tried many times to lure us to him before we recognize it. Discipleship is our willingness to seek others for the sake of Christ, long before they recognize it.

Last week, in the call to Samuel, God called many times before Samuel realized it was the Lord. It is the response, "Here I am Lord, I come to do your will," that begins another moment in the redemption of God's people. The "Here I am" prayer is the prayer of the disciple, seeking to follow one's vocation.
