## From Fr. Mark's Desk:

First Sunday of Advent: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man."

From the Book of Genesis, we receive accounts of the beginnings of the world and the beginning of humanity. When God saw everything that He had made; He saw it was good. To humanity, God gave dominion over the earth. This gift of freedom and responsibility became self-absorption on the part of humanity, which led to humanity becoming disobedient to God's will.

A 'battle' begins between the heart of God and the heart of humanity. The heart of God is grieved while the heart of humanity is serving its own purpose. God will many times attempt to correct this chasm between the heart of God and the heart of humanity. The 'Battle' takes root in the account of Noah and the Flood. In this account, God attempts through water to make all things new. Noah has been found worthy to participate in this new creation.

Maybe not to God's surprise, humanity returns to its self-serving ways, and the heart of God is again grieved. But after the flood, God chooses to exercise a heart of covenant. The rainbow becomes a symbol of that covenant.

The 'battle' will continue. The heart of God will be hurt while heart of humanity wanders from God. In time the heart of God will offer the heart of the Son, Jesus Christ. The heart of Christ, the Sacred Heart, will beat and live for the heart of humanity. If humanity can accept this gift, this heart of God, then God and His people will be reunited, the relationship restored.

Advent is not a penitential season. Advent is a time to focus on all the many ways God makes life new for us. The birth of Jesus Christ at Christmas is the pinnacle of the new life. The real meaning of Christmas is the joy of God's heart when we love and accept the Life, he intends for us.

Thus, we do not give him a chance to be with us where we feel most alone. Christmas is the renewed invitation not to be afraid and to let him —who's love is greater than our own hearts and minds---be our companion." Henri Nouwen



This program is much more than the Religious Education system familiar to all of us. For the special needs person and the SPRED team, it is a religious awakening using all of our senses. Parishes throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago host different age groups. Our Lady of the Ridge -St. Linus has a SPRED group for children ages 6-10 years old. 
